
WAKATU New Zealand

Origin: New Zealand. Initially released in 1988 as New Zealand Hallertau, Wakatu was renamed in 2011 after the Maori name for Nelson. It was bred from an open pollination of Hallertau Mittelfrüh by a New Zealandderived male.

Usage: Aroma. With a pronounced earthy-sweet floral Hallertau character underscored by tropical fruit notes, Wakatu is a standout for any



lager style, wheat, or pale hybrid beers. It makes a good supporting hop in blends for hoppy American ales.

Aroma & Flavor Characteristics: Pleasantly intense. Fresh lime zest and citrus oils with a definite Mittelfrühstyle sweetness: clover, hay, honey, and blossoms.
