

TNS Hop Oils – How To Dose

TNS Hop Oils are highly concentrated, requiring as little as 12 mL/bbl!

Important note: start small. You can always add more hop oil if needed, but you can't take it out once it's been added.

Here are three easy steps to get the most out of your TNS Hop Oil samples:

Step 1: Test



Using either a pipette or a micropipette with a range of 5 – 100 microliters, add TNS Hop Oil to 100 mL samples of beer in a range of doses: 20 microliters, 30 microliters, 40 microliters, etc. Important: remember to label the samples by dose!

Step 2: Evaluate



Gently swirl each dosed sample to mix, wait a few minutes, and evaluate the flavor and aroma of each sample. Use your notes and impressions as a guideline whether your beer needs a low, medium, or high dose to achieve its desired sensory effect.

Step 3: Scale up



Once you've selected the optimal dosage rate for your beer, it's time to scale up the dosage to production volume. Refer to the videos linked on the right or ask your BSG representative for a copy of our TNS Dosage Calculator.
